General Rules

1. Players start with 5,000 in tournament chips for a \$500 entry fee.
2. Levels 1-9 are 20 minutes. Levels 10 and above are 15 minutes.
3. In Levels 1-9, players may purchase 5,000 additional chips for \$350 or 15,000 additional chips for \$700, any time they have less than 1,000 in tournament chips.
4. For every rebuy purchased, players will receive \$50 in promo chips.
5. At the end of level 9, players may purchase an additional add-on of 10,000 in tournament chips for \$350, regardless of their current chip count.
6. For every add-on purchased, players will receive \$50 in promo chips.
7. A second seating will be offered at 1PM. Players in the second seating may purchase rebuys at the following costs, regardless of chip counts. The rates will be as follows: 1 rebuy for \$350 gets 5,000 chips. 2 Rebuys \$700 gets 10,000 chips, 3 rebuys \$1,000 gets 20,000 chips.
8. Before level 10, players will have the the option to match the current chip leader's chip count via auction.
9. 100% of funds collected at the event are donated directly to the Chance for Life Charity.
10. Must be 21 years or older and an Mlife member to participate.
11. MGM National Harbor Management may alter, change, or cancel this tournament.
12. The event will generally follow the Tournament Director Association (TDA) rules and are subject to National Harbor poker room's house rules, and any other applicable rules. All decisions at the discretion of the poker room employee acting as the Tournament Director.
